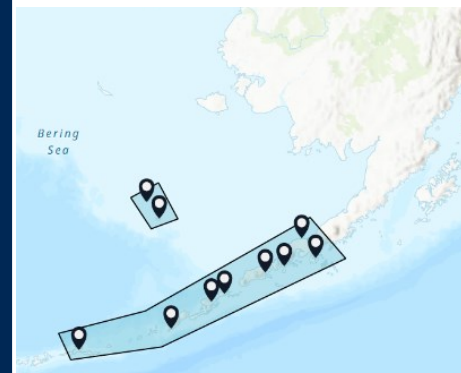


ENERGY ASSISTANCE



Need some help with the high cost of home electric and heating bills?

APIA's Energy Assistance Program could help!



Required documentation:

- Completed application
- Tribal Card, Tribal Enrollment Letter, or Certificate of Indian Blood for at least one person in the household
- Recent fuel bill
- Recent electric bill
- Paystubs from the last 30 days, or last two paystubs if paid biweekly

Income Limits:

Income for all household members age 18 and above is counted and must fall within the income limit.

1	\$2,276
2	\$3,080
3	\$3,883
4	\$4,687
5	\$5,491

Eligibility:

Alaska Native/American Indian households in Akutan, Atka, False Pass, King Cove, Nelson Lagoon, Nikolski, St. George, St. Paul, Sand Point, and Unalaska

**Applications accepted
November - April**

**Income that is NOT
counted:**

Social Security benefits (SSI/SSDI), public assistance (General Assistance, Food Stamps, Senior Care, etc.), Alaska Permanent Fund Dividends and Alaska Native Dividends.
